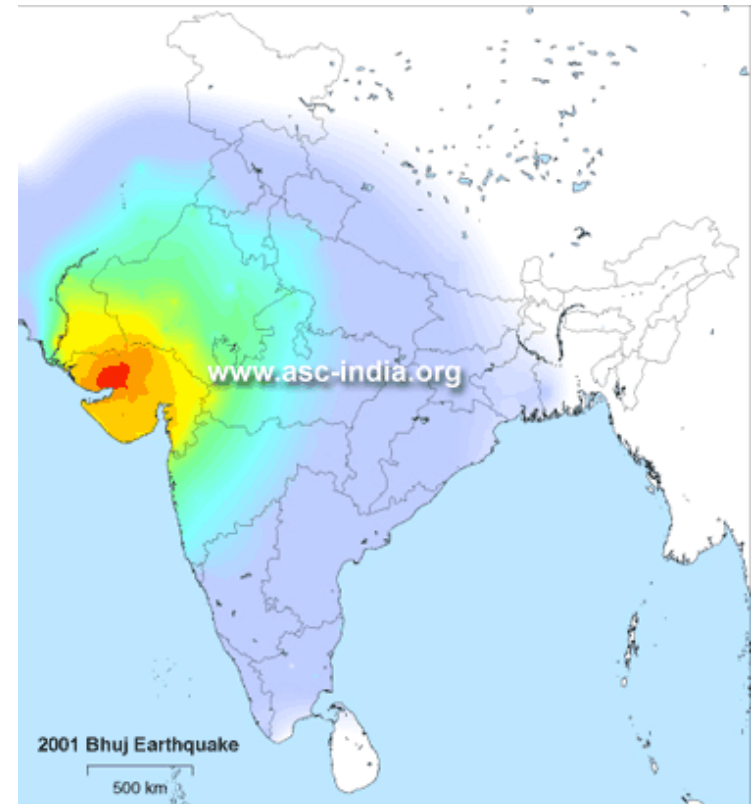

# The Disaster in General Bhuj Earthquake

- 26th of January 2001 at 8:46 AM in Gujarat, India
- Magnitude of 6.9 on the Richter Scale
- Over 18,600 deaths, over 167,000 injured
- Direct, indirect and tertiary impacts, e.g.
  - Human lives & livestock
  - Stagnating exports & imports, unemployment
  - Health hazards
- Other earthquakes in Gujarat
  - 1819, Magnitude of 8.0
  - 1956, Magnitude of 7.0

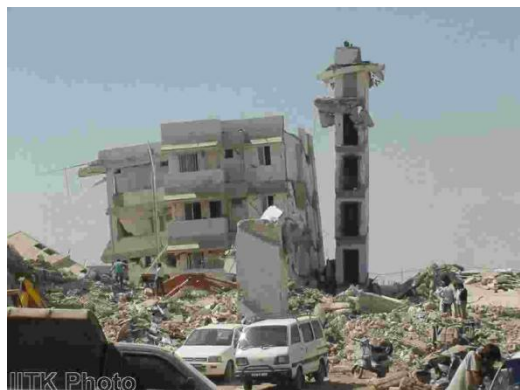
