The annual event brings together leading academics, practitioners and industry experts to explore cutting-edge developments and innovations. Nagurney's lecture, "NetwORks and Policies: OR to the Rescue," will take place on Dec. 5.

The lecture is named after Lord Patrick Blackett, who was a physicist, Nobel Prize winner and former president of the Royal Society. Blackett is considered to be a founder of OR in the U.K. during World War II.
